*“None has the right to be worshipped but Allāh Alone, He  
has no partner, His is the dominion and His is the praise, and  
He is able to do all things. O Allāh, there is none who can  
withhold what You give, and none may give what You have  
withheld; and the might of the mighty person cannot benefit  
him against You.”*

Lā ḥawla wa lā quwwata illā billāhi, lā ilāha illallāhu, wa lā na’budu illā iyyāhu, lahun-ni’matu wa laḥul-faḍlu wa laḥuth-thanā’ul-ḥasanu, lā ilāha illallāhu mukhliṣīna lahud-dīna wa law karihal-kāfirūn.

*“None has the right to be worshipped but Allāh alone, He has no partner, His is the dominion and His is the praise and He is Able to do all things. There is no power and no might except by Allāh. None has the right to be worshipped but Allāh, and we do not worship any other besides Him. His is grace, and His is bounty and to Him belongs the most excellent praise.*

*None has the right to be worshipped but Allāh. (We are) sincere in making our religious devotion to Him, even though the disbelievers may dislike it.”*

Rabbi qini ‘adhābaka yawma tab’athu ‘ibādak.

“O my Lord! Save me from Your torment on the Day when You would raise Your servants.”

Allāhummaghfirli mā qaddamtu wa mā akhkhartu wa mā asrartu wa mā a‘lantu wa mā asraftu wa mā anta a‘lamu bihi minnī, antal-Muqaddimu wa antal-Mu’akhkhiru, lā ilāha illā anta.

“Forgive me of the earlier and later, open and secret (sins) and that where I made transgression and that You know better than I. You are the First and the Last. None has the right to be worshipped but You.”

(This is said after the night [Tahajjud] prayer)

*“O Allāh forgive all my sins and wrongdoings. Revive me and  
compel me and guide me to do pious actions and to be of  
good character. And no one guides to goodness (piousness)  
and removes evil except you.”*

*"Oh Allāh! By (means of) your (help) I am trying, I am attacking and I am Fighting."*

Allāhumma a'innī 'alā dhikrika, wa shukrika, wa ḥusni  
'ibādatik.

*"O Allāh, help me in remembering You, in giving You thanks,  
and worshipping You well."*

Abī Dāwūd (no. 1524)

بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِیْمِ  
"قُلْ اَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ الْفَلَقِ \* مِنْ شَرِّ مَا خَلَقَ \*  
وَمِنْ شَرِّ غَاسِقٍ اِذَا وَقَبَ \* وَمِنْ شَرِّ النَّفَّاثَاتِ  
فِي الْعُقَدِ \* وَمِنْ شَرِّ حَاسِدٍ اِذَا حَسَدَ

*“With the Name of Allāh, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. Say: I seek refuge with (Allāh) the Lord of the daybreak, from the evil of what He has created, and from the evil of the darkening (night) as it comes with its darkness, and from the evil of those who practice witchcraft when they blow in the knots, and from the evil of the envier when he envies.”*

Who is he that can intercede with Him except with His Permission? He knows what happens to them in this world, and what will happen to them in the Hereafter. And they will never encompass anything of His Knowledge except that which He wills. His Throne extends over the heavens and the earth, and He feels no fatigue in guarding and preserving them. And He is the Most High, the Most Great.”
